What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Global Themes Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Devon Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

The Global Themes Fund will hold an investment portfolio of global financial assets and cash. These assets may include Exchange Traded Funds, listed equity securities, index funds, futures contracts, currency positions and derivative securities. The Global Themes Fund is actively managed, which means the holdings and investment returns may differ considerably from its benchmark.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Global Themes Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

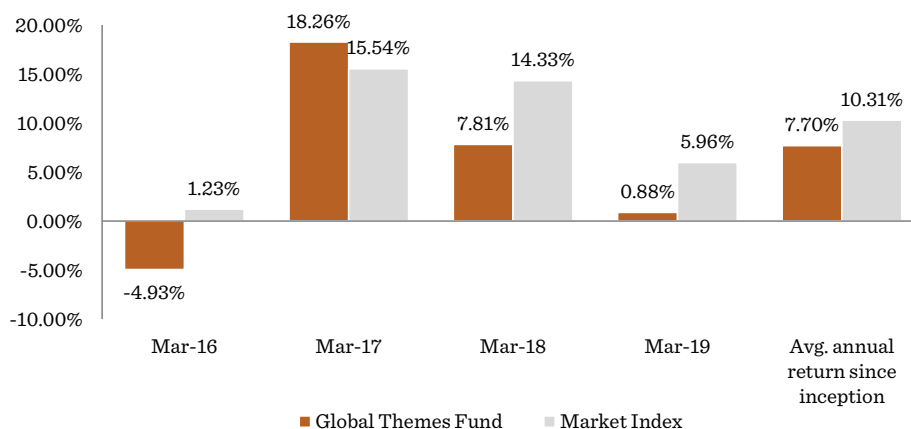

Annual return graph²

Example of how this applies to an investor

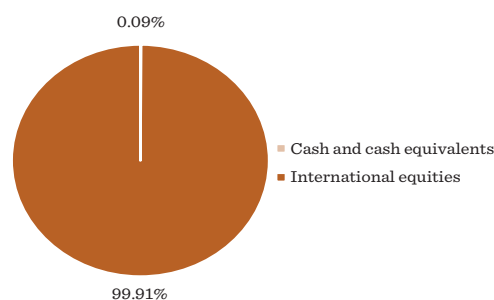
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Chris had \$10,000 in the Global Themes Fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Chris received a return after fund charges were deducted of -\$142 (that is -1.42% of his initial \$10,000). Chris does not pay any other charges. This gives Chris a total return after tax of -\$226 for the year.
